MBA@SMS, CUSAT: Academic Admissions -2022

Greetings from School of Management Studies, CUSAT.

This is with reference to the admission procedures for M.B.A(PT). program at SMS, CUSAT (2022-24). Five rounds of admission for the M.B.A. programs at SMS are now completed and **the remaining one vacant seat under KSC category for the MBA (PT) course** shall be allotted to the deserving candidate through spot admission which is scheduled **on 20th, September, 2022**, strictly based on the MBA admission 2022 rank order in the Supplementary rank list which has already been published in the CUSAT admission portal.

This round of spot allotment is applicable only for the KSC candidates who are in the MBA admission supplementary rank list published in the admission portal of the University. However, the allotment shall be made only based on rank order basis in the supplementary list.

Accordingly, you are hereby directed to report in person [*provided entrance test (CMAT/KMAT/CAT) score were entered correctly in the admission portal and you are not disqualified due to wrongly entering the entrance test (CMAT/KMAT/CAT) score in the admission portal*] and produce all the original certificates/ documents claimed in your application for physical verification at the SMS office at **9.30 am on 20th, September, 2022**. You may also bring two passport size photographs, self-attested copies (two numbers) of all the certificates and documents, and a signed print out of the undertaking form attached with this mail.

This mail is no confirmation for seat allotment to you. This mail is only an invitation to attend the final round of the allotment process, where strictly based on the supplementary list rank order for the remaining one vacant seat under KSC category for the MBA(PT) course shall be allotted.

Please note that according to the order of the University regarding spot admission, candidates who report after the stipulated time shall not have any claim for participating in the admission process under any circumstances for whatsoever be the reason. Accordingly, it is hereby informed that the allotment hall shall be closed exactly at 9.30 am, 20th, September, 2022, and candidates shall not be allowed to enter the hall after that.

In case you get the seat allotment, you may have to remit **the applicable fees (please refer the prospectus) at the time of joining the programme on the same day** and to produce the acknowledgement receipt at the time of verification.

Please Note:

- I. Candidates should note that the allotment shall be made on rank order basis to candidates present/or to candidates whose authorized person is duly present. (if the candidate is not able to attend the spot admission, and not represented by an authorized person, the candidate shall lose the claim for admission)
- II. The person authorized by the candidate should be a person who is believed to be not at risk of being COVID 19 positive/exposed to COVID 19 patients.
- III. Candidates/ such an authorized person should carry his/her Identity card and the authorization letter attested by the candidate. (without these they shall not be allowed to attend the spot admission procedures)
- IV. Candidates/ such authorized persons shall reach the SMS hall before 9.30 am 20th September, 2022. (late entry is strictly no allowed)
- V. Candidates/ such authorized person shall produce all certificates and documents as required for the spot admission process in original on behalf of the candidate. (Without these the candidate will lose their claim for admission)
- VI. They shall also be ready to remit **the applicable fees (please refer the prospectus) at the time of joining the programme on the same day** and to produce the acknowledgement receipt at the time of verification.
- VII. Please also refer to the attachments for undertaking/list of documents to be produced for verification.
- VIII. Candidates shall also bring their parent/local guardian for the admission process.
