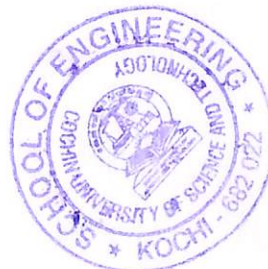

NB: Admissions to 'CUSAT Staff Child' (CHD) seat (1 supernumerary seat) in all branches of M.Tech (F.T) of SOE will also be completed the same day.

Interested candidates may appear in person with the following documents in original and two sets of self attested copies of the same and two passport size photographs at the office of the undersigned on **23.09.2022** at **10 a.m.**


- (1) Secondary School Certificate / Mark List(Tenth)
- (2) Senior Secondary School Mark List (12th)
- (3) Degree Final Mark list (OR Mark lists up to 7th semester in case if the Final semester Result is not published along with a declaration)
- (4) Degree Certificate (OR Provisional Certificate / Declaration regarding Later Submission if Final semester result is not published)
- (5) Transfer Certificate (OR Declaration regarding Later Submission if you have not received the certificate)
- (6) Conduct Certificate (OR Declaration regarding Later Submission if you have not received the certificate)
- (7) Migration Certificate (If the candidate has studied in an institution outside Kerala (Optional))
- (8) GATE Score Card (if applicable)
- (9) Certificate for Keralite Status. (List of eligible documents attached).
- (10) Community and Non Creamy Layer Certificate (if applicable)
- (11) Economically Weaker Section Certificate (if applicable)



Instructions to Candidates

1. The time for registration of admission is between 10 a.m to 11 a.m
2. Candidates reporting after 11 a.m will not be considered for admission under any circumstances.
3. The orders of preferences for admission from eligible registered candidates are as follows:-
 - (i) Candidates from GATE rank list.
 - (ii) Candidates from DAT rank list.
 - (iii) Candidates outside GATE/ DAT rank lists.
4. Candidates outside the GATE/ DAT rank lists may refer the Prospectus for Qualification details.
5. In the absence of KSC candidates, KST candidates who are otherwise qualified will be considered against such vacancies and vice versa. In the absence of both KSC/ KST candidates, OEC candidates (from GATE/ DAT rank list) who are otherwise qualified will also be considered against such vacancies.
6. Only the candidates from GATE/ DAT rank lists who have applied specifically for CHD quota seat will be considered for the same. If no such candidate exists, the seat will be left vacant.
7. Allotted candidates should remit fees online as shown below at the time of admission or else the allotment will be cancelled and other eligible registered candidate if available will be considered instead.
 - (i) SC/ST/OEC candidates- Rs.1350/- + Rs500/- (Alumni) (subject to reimbursement by the Govt. of Kerala)
 - (ii) All other candidates- Rs.35635/- + Rs.4700/- (DDF + PTA + Alumni)
8. Candidates outside the GATE/ DAT rank list must remit application fees as detailed below at the time of admission.
 - (i) SC/ ST candidates- Rs.500/-
 - (ii) All other candidates-Rs.1100/-
9. Students, who are already admitted to a branch of M.Tech (FT), if interested to change their present branch, must be present for the Spot Admission in person.
10. The community/NCL/EWS certificate furnished should be latest (within the validity period)

List of eligible documents to prove Keralite Status.

Keralite Status: Proofs accepted for Keralite Status:

Candidates claiming the Keralite status should invariably upload scanned copy of the originals of any one of the following certificates:

1. The certificate of Birth / Residence of the candidate or his/her father or mother from the Village Officer / Tahsildar or from a competent authority of local body.
2. The 'Certificate showing school studies in Kerala from Standards VIII to XII' from the Head of School where the candidate completed his / her study in Standard XII.
3. Relevant page of the SSLC of the candidate's father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and the parent.
4. Relevant page of the passport of the candidate or either of parents issued by the Government of India showing place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the parent and candidate.
5. Birth certificate of candidate or his / her, father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and father / mother whose birth certificate is being produced.
6. For claiming Keralite - AIS (All India Service), certificate from competent authority should be uploaded.

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- The uploaded certificates / documents will be verified by the concerned department at a later stage. Any discrepancies in the reservation claim and document uploaded to substantiate the claim may lead to disqualification. Hence, utmost care must be observed while uploading the documents/certificates. Similarly, Failure to produce/upload relevant documents to substantiate the communal reservation / Special reservation will disqualify your claim for admission in the respective reservation category. The candidate alone will be responsible for such incidents.
