NOTIFICATION FOR SPOT ADMISSION

Sub: M.Tech Spot admission for Instrumentation Technology

A spot admission for filling up the vacant seats in the M.Tech Instrumentation Technology of the Department of Instrumentation, Cochin University of Science and Technology is scheduled to be held on **18.07.2023** The qualifications prescribed are as follows:

*B.Tech or equivalent degree in Instrumentation/ Instrumentation Technology / Instrumentation and Control/ Applied Electronics and Instrumentation/ Electronics and Instrumentation/ Electronics and Communication/ Electrical and Electronics or MSc Degree in Instrumentation/ Electronics with a **minimum of 60% marks or CGPA 6.5 in 10 point scale** from any recognized University or Institution.

Relaxation in marks in qualifying examination is available to the following categories:

a) 5% relaxation in the minimum required marks in the qualifying exam to candidates with valid GATE score in the concerned branch of study.

b) 5% relaxation in the minimum required marks in the qualifying exam to SEBC of Kerala State who are certified as belonging to Non Creamy Layer.

c) A minimum pass marks in the qualifying examination is required to candidates belonging to Kerala Scheduled Caste(KSC) and Kerala Scheduled Tribe(KST) communities.


➤ Candidates without GATE can also apply but preference will be given to GATE candidates and the DAT Rank List.

➤ For sponsored candidates, in addition to the above two conditions, 3 years teaching / research experience in Govt./ Quasi Govt institutions or 3 years experience in the Public sector Units / Public Ltd. companies.
