

CAT 2024 – Instruction to the Candidates

- 1) Candidates appearing for more than one exam, need to download separate Admit cards.
- 2) Candidates Opted only for Integrated Biological Sciences, have to attend the CAT 2024 with two sessions morning session with test code 104 (Physics,Chemistry) and afternoon session with test code 104 (Biology) (**separate Admit cards**).
- 3) Candidates Opted for both Integrated Biological Sciences and B.Tech Programmes need to attend 101 and 104 test codes with two admit cards. One for morning session with test code 101(Physics,Chemistry,Maths) and another for afternoon with test code 104 (Biology) (**separate Admit cards**).

Candidates must produce the following Id Proof along with the admit card at the Examination venue.

- 1). Colour printout of E-Aadhar
- 2). Voter's ID card / Driving License / School or College Identity Card / valid Passport / Aadhar Card/PAN Card in Original.
- 3). Any of the above Govt. Issued photo identity cards (digital format) shown directly from **DigiLocker, the digital locker facility provided by the Government of India** is also permitted as an identity proof.
- 4). **No other mode of digital documents is permitted.**
- 5). **Ration Card will not be accepted as valid id proof for this examination**
- 6). Candidates who do not possess any of the identity proof mentioned above should prepare in duplicate an Identity Certificate in the prescribed format with his/her photo and signature affixed in the space provided, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer of State or Central Government, and should bring it to the examination hall .
- 7). Candidates, those application has been withheld due to defective Photo/Signature are eligible to attend the CAT 2024 examinations. They have to affix a recent passport size photograph on the downloaded Admit Card and get it duly attested by a Gazetted Officer of State or Central Govt. (Name, Designation and office seal of the attesting Officer must be clearly visible) The candidate should affix the signature in the presence of the attesting officer in the space provided in the admit card and get it attested. Candidates should handover the attested admit card to the invigilator at the test center, they may keep an additional photo copy for their records
- 8). The reporting time for candidates for all the sessions would be 90 minutes prior to the commencement of the test. Gate closure Time is 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the test.
