INSTRUCTIONS FOR REAL TIME COUNSELING

1. Candidates for Integrated Msc Mathematics/Physics/Statistics/Chemistry/Biological Sciences/ Photonics/ Computer Science (AI & DS)/Environmental Science and Technology (Stream I and Stream II)/MCA with CAT 2025 rank (range mentioned below) can attend the Real Time Counselling as scheduled below.

Individual call letter will not be sent to the candidates. Candidates should register at the venue **before 10.30 am** on the date of Real Time Counselling (as per the schedule). Candidates who do not report before 10.30 am at the venue will not be considered for counselling.

2. **Real Time Counselling Venue: Seminar Complex, Near Administrative Office, Cochin University of Science and Technology, South Kalamassery, Kochi-682022**
3. Read the Prospectus published in the website <https://admissions.cusat.ac.in> and make sure that the candidate fulfills the required eligibility criteria.
4. Programmes will be allotted to the candidates who registered for Real Time Counseling, strictly on the basis of the CAT rank. The QR code with the links to the registration portal will be available at the venue.
5. **Non Keralite candidates are not eligible for communal reservation.**

6. Candidates coming for Real Time Counseling should remit the required fee immediately after the allotment through online only. The fee payment will be enabled in the candidate profile and they can complete the fees payment through online.
7. Candidates should upload scanned copies of the qualifying certificates in the specified format (size less than 1 mb, PDF format) before proceeding to fee payments once they get allotment. (Uploading of Soft copy of qualifying Certificate (Plus Two) and Matriculation Certificate (10th) are mandatory).
8. If a candidate fails to remit the fees within the stipulated time, the admission will be summarily cancelled without further notice.
9. If a candidate fails to remit the fees, the admission will be summarily cancelled without further notice.
10. The candidates need to pay the additional fees of PTA/DDF etc., at the time of Real Time Counseling to the Department concerned.
11. **A waiting list will be generated for each programme with the candidates who report for the Real Time Counseling and do not receive allotment on the counseling date. Future vacancies arising in the respective programme will be filled from the waiting list after giving preference to the candidates already admitted for change of category, strictly based on the CAT rank and reservation rules. Next call for Real Time admission will be made only after exhausting the waiting list so prepared. So all those who are interested in these programmes within the rank range mentioned should report for the Real Time counseling without fail. Any future claim on this matter will not be entertained.**
12. **The following certificates/documents should be submitted in original at the time of counseling/admission.**
 - CAT – 2025 Admit Card/Online application Registration Confirmation Page.
 - Migration Certificate (for students from outside Kerala state)
 - S.S.L.C/10th Mark list & pass certificate (CBSE, ICSE etc.).
 - Plus 2 Mark lists / and pass certificate (CBSE, ICSE etc.).
 - Certificate to prove Keralite Status, for State Merit Seats
 - Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended (in English version)
 - Four passport size Photographs of the candidate
 - Aadhar Card
 - Community and Non-Creamy Layer certificate in the case of 'SEBC' candidates.
 - Community certificate issued by the Tahsildar in the case of Kerala Scheduled Caste (KSC)/ Kerala Scheduled Tribe (KST) candidates.
 - Candidates seeking admission under physically challenged (PHC) category should invariably produce a valid Physically Handicapped certificate issued by the District Medical Board of the State to which the candidate belongs.
 - If any of the above certificates are not in English/Malayalam, Candidates should invariably produce a translated version of the same in English endorsed by a Notary Public.

- Two sets of self-attested copies of all the original certificates/documents mentioned above.
- NRI status is not compulsory but those who have opted for NRI seats should submit the 'Declaration' given in **Annexure I**.

Those who do not have Original Certificates at position need to submit an undertaking to the effect that they will produce the same within the time allotted by the concerned Departments.

Self-Declaration stating "Nationality"

All candidates receiving allotments to Academic Programmes of CUSAT in seats other than those specifically marked/set aside for "International / Foreign National Candidates" shall submit a self-declaration stating their "Nationality", i.e all candidates who receive allotments to "General (All India Merit/State Merit / All India Quota)", "OBC/SEBC", KSC, KST, NRI, EWS (Economically Weaker Section,) Sports Quota, Differently Abled, Transgender, Child Quota, IDC etc Must compulsorily submit the above-mentioned declaration. **(Please see Annexure II for format).**

The candidates joining CUSAT shall sign the following declarations at the time of admission:

- 1 It has been suggested by the UGC that an anti-drug declaration be taken from the students at the time of admission to invoke a commitment from the students to have responsible behaviour during studies (Annexure – III)
- 2 It is compulsory for each and every student and parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at www.antiragging.in. The students will receive a e-mail with his/her registration number. The anti-ragging undertaking reference number should be provided to the department at the time of admission/verification.
- 3 An Anti dowry declaration has to be signed by the students at the time of admission (Annexure – IV)
13. Candidates claiming the Keralite status should invariably produce, at the time of counseling/admission, any one of the following certificates.
 - a. The certificate of Birth / Residence of the candidate or his/her father or mother from the Village Officer / Tahsildar or from a competent authority of local body, OR
 - b. The 'Certificate showing school studies in Kerala from Standards VIII to XII' from the Head of School where the candidate completed his / her study in Standard XII, OR
 - c. True copy of the relevant page of the SSLC of the candidate's father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and the parent, OR
 - d. True copy of the relevant page of the passport of the candidate or either of parents issued by the Government of India showing place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the parent and candidate, OR
 - e. True copy of birth certificate of candidate or his / her, father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and father / mother of whose birth certificate is being produced For claiming Keralite-AIS (All India Service), certificate from competent authority should be attached.
14. The University reserves the right to add, delete or amend any of the stipulations regarding eligibility, intake, specialization, type of programmes, rules, regulations, fee structure etc. at any time and these will be applicable to the candidates seeking admission.
