**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CENTRALIZED REALTIME ADMISSION FOR
M.TECH. PROGRAMMES**

Rank Lists of GATE qualified candidates who have applied for admission to the various M.Tech programmes offered by the University have been published in the admissions portal <http://admissions.cusat.ac.in>.

All candidates included in the GATE rank lists of the following M.Tech programmes offered by the University are requested to report in person for the centralized GATE Real Time admissions process scheduled to be held on 18th of June 2026 (Thursday) in the **Seminar Complex, Cochin University of Science and Technology, Thrikkakara, Kochi -682022:-**

Candidates should strictly report for admission by 9.30 am on the date mentioned above at the venue. Candidate registration starts at 9.30 am. Registration closes by 10.30 am. **Candidates reporting after 10.30 am will not be allowed to register for the real-time admission process.** Candidates who are in rank lists of multiple M.Tech programmes have to register only once at the registration desk. The candidate will be considered for all the programmes for which they have been ranked. Read the Prospectus published in the website <https://admissions.cusat.ac.in/> and make sure that the candidate fulfills the required eligibility criteria.

Registration for the centralized real-time admission process will close at **10.30 a.m.** After the closure of registration, candidates are requested to be present near the admission desk/bench of the department offering the programme in which they intend to seek admission.

The admission process will commence at **11.00 a.m.** Department officials will call candidates in the order of their rank from the published rank list. Eligible candidates will be offered allotment based on rank, reservation eligibility, seat availability.

Once a seat is allotted, the allotment details will be published in the candidate's profile. The candidate shall log in to the admission portal and access the “**Allotment Status**” tab available on the home page. The candidate shall then confirm the allotment, upload the required documents, and proceed to the online fee payment page.

The admission fee shall be remitted through the online payment facility provided in the candidate's profile. After fee payment the candidate can contact department admission desk for document verification. The allotment process will be treated as complete only after successful payment of the prescribed fee and verification of the documents within the stipulated time.

Once the payment to a particular programme is completed, the allotment to other programme allotted will be automatically cancelled. No claim by the candidate will be entertained on the previous allotment offered. **If a candidate fails to remit the fees on time the allotment offered to the candidate will be summarily cancelled without further notice.** The candidates need to pay the additional fees of PTA/DDF etc., at the time of admission to the Department concerned.

It is to be noted that the allotment depends on the eligibility and availability of seats for the particular programme. Mere registration for the admission process do not guarantee allotment/admission to a particular programme. No such claim will be entertained from the candidate.

Certificates submitted for verification

I. Upon receiving an allotment to M.Tech at Programme, applicants shall produce originals of the following documents for verification by the respective departments.

1. **S.S.L.C / 10th Standard Certificate & Mark List.**
2. **Senior Secondary School Certificate (12th Standard).**
3. **Final/Consolidated Mark List of the qualifying degree examination** (If final year/final semester results are not yet published, such candidates shall submit all the available mark lists up to and including the semester for which the results are published along with a declaration with signature affixed, stating that

“Final / Consolidated mark list of the qualifying degree will be produced later, but before the registration for the first semester examinations. I am aware of the fact that, the University reserves the right to cancel my candidature / remove me from the rolls if I fail to produce the document to substantiate my educational qualification before the registration for the first semester examinations.”)

4. **Degree Certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate** (If final results are not yet published, such candidates shall submit a declaration with signature affixed, stating that

“Final Degree Certificate / Provisional Certificate will be produced later, but before the registration for the first semester examinations. I am aware of the fact that, the University reserves the right to cancel my candidature / remove me from the rolls if I fail to produce the document to substantiate my educational qualification before the registration for the first semester examinations.”)

5. **Transfer Certificate from the Institution/Department last attended.** (If the candidate has not received the Transfer Certificate, such candidates shall submit declaration with signature affixed, stating that

“Transfer Certificate will be produced later, but before the commencement of classes. I am aware of the fact that, the University reserves the right to cancel my candidature / remove me from the rolls if I fail to produce the Transfer Certificate from the Institution/Department last attended before the commencement of classes.”

6. **Conduct Certificate from the Institution/Department last attended.** (If the candidate has not received the Conduct Certificate, such candidates shall submit a declaration with signature affixed, stating that

“Conduct Certificate will be produced later, but before the commencement of classes. I am aware of the fact that, the University reserves the right to cancel my candidature / remove me from the rolls if I fail to produce the Conduct Certificate from the Institution/Department last attended before the commencement of classes.”

7. Valid GATE Score Card in the case of GATE qualified candidates.

II. Certificates - Proof for availing communal/special reservation

- a. Kerala Scheduled Caste (KSC)/Kerala Scheduled Tribe (KST) Candidates should submit a valid & original Community Certificate issued by the Tahasildar.
- b. SEBC candidates i.e. Ezhava /Thiyya/Billava (ETB), Muslim(MSM), Latin Catholic or Anglo-Indian(LCC), Other Backward Christian (OBX), Other Backward Hindus (OBH), Dheevera (DHV), Kudumbi (KMB), Pot Making Communities (PMC) and Viswakarma (VSK) etc. should submit a valid & original Community Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer certificate issued by the Village Officer. If the community/category is clearly specified in the Non-creamy layer certificate, no separate community certificate is required.
- c. OBH candidates eligible for fee concession as applicable to OEC candidates should produce a valid & original income certificate issued by competent authority to prove their eligibility.
- d. Applicants belonging to “General” category and have claimed reservation under “Economically Weaker Section - EWS” should produce of a valid & original Certificate issued by the competent authority for the purpose of claiming EWS reservation.
- e. Other certificates (if applicable) : Relevant/Appropriate Certificate issued by Competent Authority for substantiating claim for any other reservation seats mentioned under supernumerary seats if the candidate is allotted to a seat under that category.

III. Keralite Status: Proofs accepted for Keralite Status: Candidates claiming the Keralite status should submit the originals of any one of the following certificates:

1. The certificate of Birth / Residence of the candidate or his/her father or mother from the Village Officer / Tahsildar or from a competent authority of local body.
2. The 'Certificate showing school studies in Kerala from Standards VIII to XII' from the Head of School where the candidate completed his / her study in Standard XII.
3. Relevant page of the SSLC of the candidate's father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and the parent.
4. Relevant page of the passport of the candidate or either of parents issued by the Government of India showing place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the parent and candidate.
5. Birth certificate of candidate or his / her, father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and father / mother whose birth certificate is being produced.
6. For claiming Keralite - AIS (All India Service), certificate from competent authority should be submitted.

How to make online fee payment

For making online payment of fees the candidates who got allotment should follow the instructions given below:

1. Login to your home/login page using your Username (email id) and Password in the Admission Portal <https://admissions.cusat.ac.in/>
2. The details of the allotments received will be displayed with a button to confirm allotment.
3. Upon clicking the 'Allotment confirmation/ payment' button, you will be directed to the page for uploading the certificates, programme confirmation and fee payment. You have to enter your aadhar number and then click on the 'PAY' button. You can make payment through Credit card or Debit Card /through Net Banking/UPI.
 - a. Note: It may be noted that payment through some Debit Cards has a monetary ceiling and, in such cases, opt for other payment options.

4. Refer admission website <https://admissions.cusat.ac.in/> for the fee structure.
5. Candidates are advised to confirm the payment status as successful after the payment in their profile. After successful payment, the allotment status will show as “Provisionally Admitted” to the programme allotted. In case if there are any issues contact or inform our help desk before the last date of payment.

Candidates need to pay the additional fees of PTA/Department Development Fund (if applicable), CUSAT Alumni fee (if applicable), Matriculation fee (if applicable) etc directly, later at the Department/School as per the instructions received from the concerned Department/School.

The candidates joining CUSAT shall sign the following declarations at the time of admission:

- 1 It has been suggested by the UGC that an anti-drug declaration be taken from the students at the time of admission to invoke a commitment from the students to have responsible behaviour during studies (Annexure – III)
- 2 It is compulsory for each and every student and parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at www.antiragging.in. The students will receive a e-mail with his/her registration number. The anti-ragging undertaking reference number should be provided to the department at the time of admission/verification.
- 3 An Anti dowry declaration has to be signed by the students at the time of admission(Annexure – IV)

The University reserves the right to add, delete or amend any of the stipulations regarding eligibility, intake, specialization, type of programmes, rules, regulations, fee structure etc. at any time and these will be applicable to the candidates seeking admission.
