9. Medical fitness Certificate issued by a D.G. Shipping approved doctor *
10. Valid Indian Passport # (Original and **one self-attested copy**)
11. Nativity Certificate **
12. Community/Caste certificate (Validity - 1 year) **
13. Income Certificate (Validity - 1 year) **
14. Non-creamy layer certificate (For State Educational Purpose) (Validity - 1 year) **

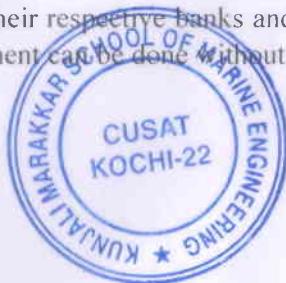

Candidate may be provisionally admitted to the programme if they produce the documentary evidence for submitting the passport application and awaiting delivery. However they will have to submit the valid passport within 10 days. No further extension of time limit shall be given for producing the passport in original.

Candidates will have to remit the first semester fees (as applicable) in full at the time of admission (candidates need to pay the additional fee of PTA, INDoS, CUSAT Alumni, Department Development Fund, Green Campus Initiative etc. directly to the department after taking admission). Those who fail to attend the counselling session on the prescribed date and time shall forfeit their claim for admission.

The candidates are directed to contact their respective banks and **enable Net Banking or upgrade their Debit/Credit Card**, so that the fee payment can be done without any hassle.
