

THIRD REAL-TIME ADMISSION TO MANAGEMENT PROGRAMMES

The third real-time admission to the vacant seats in the management programmes of the University (MBA (Full Time), MBA (Evening-Regular), and International Dual Masters Programme) is to be held on 29/07/2026, details as given below.

MBA (FULL TIME) AND MBA (EVENING REGULAR)

Date: 29/07/2026 (Wednesday)

Venue: Auditorium, School of Management Studies, CUSAT

Reporting time: 9.00 am to 10.00 am (No entry permitted after 10.00 am)

Instructions for MBA (FT) Programme Candidates

The third real-time allotment will take place in two rounds.

ROUND 1

For AIQ / GEN seats, candidates in the main rank list can attend the third real-time allotment. For other categories, all candidates who have already applied to the MBA programme with a valid KMAT/CMAT/ IIM CAT score can attend the third real-time allotment. Preference will be given to the candidates in the main rank list. Once the candidates in the main rank list are exhausted, candidates in the supplementary rank list will be considered. Once the supplementary rank list is also exhausted, the applicants not included in the rank lists, but who have already applied with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score, will be considered for the vacant seats, ranked in accordance with the normalised score of their KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT. Those who have not applied to the MBA programme cannot participate in the third real-time allotment (except for KST seats).

Note: Candidates already admitted to Management programmes can also participate in the real-time admission if they are interested in changing their category/programme.

ROUND 2 (SPECIAL ROUND FOR VACANT KSC/KST SEATS)

If KSC/ KST are still vacant after the first round, they will be offered to the candidate who has not submitted an online application. The candidates with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score obtained in the first session of the KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT can participate in the real-time admission programme. Candidates will be ranked in accordance with their normalised score in the KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT examination and will be called upon to fill the vacant seats.

ROUND 3 (SPECIAL ROUND FOR INTERCHANGING OF KSC/KST SEATS)

If KSC/KST seats are still vacant, the seats will be interchanged to KSC/KST and offered to the available candidates included in the main rank list. If sufficient candidates are not available in the main rank list, the seats will be offered to the candidates in the supplementary rank list. Once the

supplementary rank list is also exhausted, the applicants not included in the rank lists but who have already applied with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score will be considered for the vacant seats

Instructions for MBA (ER) Programme Candidates

The third real-time allotment will take place in two rounds.

ROUND 1

All candidates who have already applied to the MBA programme with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score can attend the third Real-time allotment. Preference will be given to the candidates in the main rank list. Once the candidates in the main rank list are exhausted, candidates in the supplementary rank list will be considered. Once the supplementary rank list is also exhausted, the applicants not included in the rank lists, but who have already applied with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score, will be considered for the vacant seats, ranked in accordance with the normalised score of their KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT. Those who have not applied to the MBA programme cannot participate in the third real-time allotment (except for KST seats).

Note: Candidates already admitted to Management programmes can also participate in the real-time admission if they are interested in changing their category/programme.

ROUND 2

If seats in SEBC seats (except KSC, KST, and supernumerary) are still vacant, they will be converted to general seats as per the university norms **immediately after completion of Round 1**. These seats will be offered to candidates in the order of general merit in round 2, which takes place immediately after round 1 on the same day.

If KSC/ KST are still vacant after the first round, they will be offered to the candidate who has not submitted an online application. The candidates with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score obtained in the first session of the KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT can participate in the real time admission programme. Candidates will be ranked in accordance with their normalised score in the KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT examination and will be called upon to fill the vacant seats.

ROUND 3

If KSC/KST seats are still vacant, the seats will be interchanged to KSC/KST and offered to the available candidates included in the main rank list. If sufficient candidates are not available in the main rank list, the seats will be offered to the candidates in the supplementary rank list. Once the supplementary rank list is also exhausted, the applicants not included in the rank lists, but who have already applied with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score, will be considered for the vacant seats.

INTERNATIONAL DUAL MASTERS PROGRAMME IN MANAGEMENT **(IDMPM)**

Venue: Auditorium, School of Management Studies, CUSAT

Reporting time: 1.00 pm to 2.00 pm (No entry permitted after 2.00 pm)

Instructions for IDMPM Candidates

The third real-time allotment will take place in two rounds.

ROUND 1

All candidates who have already applied to the IDMPM programme with a valid KMAT/CMAT/ IIM CAT score can attend the third real-time allotment. Preference will be given to the candidates in the main rank list. Once the candidates in the main rank list are exhausted, candidates in the supplementary rank lists (list 1 followed by list 2) will be considered. Once the supplementary rank list is also exhausted, the applicants not included in the rank lists, but who have already applied with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score, will be considered for the vacant seats, ranked in accordance with the normalised score of their KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT. Those who have not applied to the IDMPM programme cannot participate in the third real-time allotment (except for KST seats)

ROUND 2 (Conversion of SEBC seats to General Quota)

If seats in SEBC seats (except KSC, KST, and supernumerary) are still vacant, they will be converted to general seats as per the university norms **immediately after completion of Round 1**. These seats will be offered to candidates in the order of general merit in round 2, which takes place immediately after round 1 on the same day.

If KSC/ KST are still vacant after the first round, they will be offered to the candidate who has not submitted an online application. The candidates with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score obtained in the first session of the KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT can participate in the real-time admission programme. Candidates will be ranked in accordance with their normalised score in the KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT examination and will be called upon to fill the vacant seats.

ROUND 3

If KSC/KST seats are still vacant, the seats will be interchanged to KSC/KST and offered to the available candidates included in the main rank list. If sufficient candidates are not available in the main rank list, the seats will be offered to the candidates in the supplementary rank list. Once the supplementary rank list is also exhausted, the applicants not included in the rank lists, but who have already applied with a valid KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT score, will be considered for the vacant seats

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOTH MBA & IDMPM PROGRAMMES

The candidates registering on time will be ranked as mentioned above and will be called upon on the basis of the rank to take up the seats available. (Details of vacant seats are given in Annexure I).

Once the candidates in the main and supplementary rank lists are exhausted, the applicants who are not included in the rank list will be ranked in accordance with the normalised score of their KMAT/CMAT/IIM CAT and be called upon on the basis of the rank to take up the seats available. During the Realtime Admission, “generated vacancies” (i.e., seats that become available when a candidate moves from one allotted seat to another), will be added to the live vacancy list immediately for the current round if the generated seat category currently has a vacancy above zero.

The candidates have to submit the documents required for verification (List attached Annexure II). Upon verification, the candidates will be required to remit the fees required (See Annexure III).

The candidates shall remit the fee immediately after verification of the admission to confirm the admission.
